Annual Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals
Fiscal Year 2016

The College of Charleston received one hundred and twelve awards totaling \$5,856,513 in external funding during the fiscal year 2016. Of these awarded funds, seventy-five percent came from federal sources.

During the same period, one hundred and twenty-two proposals requesting \$18,477,468 in funding were submitted to sixty-four different sponsors. Of the requested funds eighty-six percent was requested from federal sources. The sponsor to which the most proposals were submitted was the National Science Foundation, with twenty-six proposals. Multiple proposals were also submitted to SC Space Grant Consortium, NASA, and National Institutes of Health.
