Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals
Fiscal Year 2017

The College of Charleston received one hundred and seven awards totaling **\$6,454,303** in external funding during fiscal year 2017. Of these awarded funds, seventy-eight percent came from federal sources. The largest funders during fiscal year 2017 were NASA (\$1,623,770), US Department of Education (\$1,467,848) and the National Institutes of Health (\$745,392).

During the same period, one hundred and twenty proposals requesting \$27,514,562 in funding were submitted to sixty different sponsors. Of the requested funds eighty-seven percent was requested from federal sources. The sponsor to which the most proposals were submitted was the National Science Foundation, with thirty proposals. Multiple proposals were also submitted to NASA, National Institutes of Health, and National Endowment for the Humanities.
