Quarterly Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals
Fiscal Year 2017, Fourth Quarter

The College of Charleston received twenty-three awards totaling \$1,281,509 in external funding during the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2017. Of these awarded funds, eighty-two percent came from federal sources.

During the same period, twenty-six proposals requesting \$2,483, in funding were submitted to fifteen different external sponsors and one internal. Of the requested funds eighty percent was requested from federal sources. The sponsor to which the most proposals were submitted was the NASA with 3 external and three internal proposals. Multiple proposals were also submitted to SC Sea Grant Consortium and Slocum-Lunz Foundation.
