Annual Report on External Funding Fiscal Year 2006-2007

The College of Charleston received \$5,533,787 in external funding during fiscal year 2007. Eighty-four percent of the funding came from federal sources. There were 98 awards, the same number as in fiscal year 2006. Although the total funding was less than the record (\$7,111,597) funding in fiscal year 2006, this can largely be explained by the noticeable trend in fiscal year 2007 toward single year awards. The previous fiscal year, over \$1.7 million of our funding was for multi-year awards.* However, in fiscal year 2007, less than \$700,000 was for multi-year awards. This single-year award trend was very noticeable with the National Science Foundation funding, the College's number one funding sponsor in fiscal year 2006 and the number three funding sponsor in fiscal year 2007. In fiscal year 2006, 62% of the College's National Science Foundation awards were multi-year grants, compared to 30% in fiscal year 2007.

During fiscal year 2007 a number of federal agencies experienced budget uncertainties that affected award-making. Whether we can expect this single-year award trend to continue depends on federal budget and agency decisions.

Awards received with a project begin date of July 1, 2007 or later will be credited to fiscal year 2007-2008.
