## Annual Report on External Funding Fiscal Year 2008-2009

The College of Charleston was awarded \$5,159,925 in external funding during fiscal year 2009. Seventy-seven percent of the funds came from federal sources. There were 87 awards in fiscal year 2009.

The National Science Foundation was the College's number one funding sponsor in fiscal year 2009 with \$1,229,616. The US Department of Education awarded the second highest amount to the College with \$881,007.

Awards received on July 1, 2009 or later will be credited to fiscal year 2009-2010.
