Annual Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals Fiscal Year 2013 July 1, 2012—June 30, 2013

The College of Charleston received 71 awards totaling \$8,386,172 in external funding during fiscal year 2013 (July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013). Of these awarded funds, seventy-four percent came from federal sources.

During the same period, on hundred and twelve proposals requesting \$22,938,410 in funding were submitted to fifty-eight different sponsors. Of the requested funds, eighty-two percent was requested from federal sources. The sponsor to which the most proposals were submitted was National Science Foundation, with twenty-two proposals. The next most prevalent sponsor was NASA with twenty proposals, eleven of which through the NASA EPSCOR program.
