Yearly Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals
Fiscal Year 2019

The College of Charleston received **109** awards totaling **\$5,193,159** in external funding during fiscal year 2019. Of these awarded funds, **83%** came from federal sources. The College of Charleston received the most awards from The National Institute of Health as well as numerous awards from National Science Foundation, National Aeronautics and Space Administration, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources.

During the same fiscal period, **134** proposals requesting **\$23,059,599** in funding were submitted to **59** different sponsors. **94%** of these funds were requested from federal sources. The sponsor to which the most proposals were submitted was the National Science Foundation with **28** proposals. Multiple proposals were also submitted to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the Department of Health and Human Services, and the National Endowment for the Arts.

Schools within the College of Charleston received **97** grants. The School of Sciences & Mathematics received **53** awards and **\$3,188,981** in funding. The School of Humanities & Social Sciences received the second highest amount of awards with **\$574,036** in funding from **24** awards. Each College of Charleston School was awarded multiple grants, as was the Graduate School. The six schools and the Graduate School were awarded a total funding amount of **\$4,186,096**. The remaining grants were awarded to Student Affairs, Student Health Services, Multicultural Student Programs and Services, and the library.

Among the many exciting projects to receive funding, there are several to spotlight. Approximately \$121,000 was awarded by the South Carolina Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services to the College of Charleston's Collegiate Recovery Communities and Programs; the funds are dedicated to covering the expenses of hiring academic support specialists for students, conducting peer recovery-support trainings, creating opportunities for students to travel to conferences and events with other students in recovery, and exploring dedicated sober living options on campus. Approximately \$24,500 was awarded by the US State Department to Bret Lott to facilitate a peer mentoring program between College of Charleston MFA students and students at the University of Bahrain in Creative Writing; in May of 2019, Lott and two graduate students returned to Bahrain for a second session of programming and will conduct a third in May of 2020. Additionally, Beth Sundstrom of the Communications Department, in collaboration with a larger project with the Medical University of South Carolina, received approximately \$40,000 from the National Institutes of Health for a social media campaign to increase HPV vaccinations in South Carolina.
