### Yearly Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals

### Fiscal Year 2021

The College of Charleston received 129 awards totaling \$42,051,313 in external funding during fiscal year 2021. Of these awarded funds, 60.47% came from federal sources. The College of Charleston received the most awards from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, totaling \$2,698,826 across 21 awards.

During the same fiscal period, 220 proposals requesting \$27,677,594 in funding were submitted to 90 different sponsors. 67.73% of these funds were requested from federal sources. The sponsors to which the most proposals were submitted were the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the National Science Foundation (NSF), with 31 and 26 proposal submissions, respectively.

Seven Schools within the College of Charleston received 109 grants, totaling \$5,937,847. The seven schools include: Arts; Business; Education, Health and Human Performance; The Graduate School; Humanities and Social Sciences; Languages, Cultures and World Affairs; and Sciences and Mathematics. The School of Sciences & Mathematics received 72 awards and \$5,124,003 in funding. The School of Humanities & Social Sciences received the second highest amount of awards with \$304,937 in funding from 17 awards. The remaining grants were awarded to College of Charleston Libraries, Multicultural Student Programs and Services, Student Health Services, the Office of Sustainability, and Upward Bound. Thanks to the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund for COVID-19 from the U.S. Department of Education as well as the SC CARES Act Funds from the U.S. Department of the Treasury, an additional \$35,268,401 in funds were granted to the institution as a whole for costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Among the many exciting projects to receive funding, there are several to spotlight. Dr. Cass Runyon with the Geology and Environmental Geosciences Department received a total of \$2,474,961 in funding from NASA in support of 10 different projects and programs. \$950,000 of Dr. Runyon's total funding will support South Carolina Space Grant Consortium's Opportunities in STEM for FY20-24. Dr. Erik Sotka in the Biology Department received \$301,152 in total funding from the National Park Services Cooperative Ecosystem Studies Unites (CESU) Program in support of his project titled, "Genotyping corals for restoration and rescue at multiple coral reef parks: BUIS/DRTO/SARI/VICR/VIIS PMIS# 264595." Morgan Hughey in the Health and Human Performance Department received \$11,250 from the Citadel's U.S. Department of Transportation grants to support her "STRIDE Project – The Evaluation of Transportation Network Infrastructure, Safety, and Travel Route Characteristics of Bike Share, Electric-Powered Pedal-Assist Bike Share, and Electric Scooter System Operation." Finally, the Halsey Institute received a total funding amount of \$32,000 across The National Endowment for the Arts and SC Humanities in order to host 3 exhibits for FY21: Kukuli Velarde, Dis/Placements: Revisitations of Home, and LISTEN: the Catawba Nation.
