Yearly Report on External Funding Activity—Awards & Proposals Fiscal Year 2020

The College of Charleston received **108** awards totaling **\$13,796,449** in external funding during fiscal year 2019. Of these awarded funds, **92%** came from federal sources. The College of Charleston received the most awards from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, totaling \$2,187,202 across 13 awards.

During the same fiscal period, **106** proposals requesting **\$26,060,426** in funding were submitted to **56** different sponsors. **88%** of these funds were requested from federal sources. The sponsors to which the most proposals were submitted were the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and the National Institutes of Health for a total of 15 proposals each.

Schools within the College of Charleston received **97** grants. The School of Sciences & Mathematics received **56** awards and **\$4,839,569** in funding. The School of Humanities & Social Sciences received the second highest amount of awards with **\$265,342** in funding from **20** awards. Five of the Schools at the College of Charleston were awarded funding, totaling **\$5,558,993**. The remaining grants were awarded to Upward Bound, Student Health Services, Public Safety, and the Office of the President. Thanks to the federal CARES Act funding to institutions of higher education during the COVID-19 quarantines, additional funds were granted to the institution as a whole for costs related to the pandemic.

Among the many exciting projects to receive funding, there are several to spotlight. \$35,000 was awarded by the National Endowment for the Arts to Bryan Granger for his project titled "Namsa Leuba: Crossed Looks. This funding supported a solo exhibition of Swiss-Guinean artist, Namsa Leuba, who, through her work, examines the representation of African identity in the Western imagination. Aaisha Haykal received \$25,000 from Digital Public Library of America to help digitize the Black Women's Suffrage Collection at the Avery Research Center. Haykal chose a combination of highly requested and underutilized/hidden collections that provide insight into the activities of Black women from South Carolina. Additionally, Mike Larsen was awarded nearly \$400,000 from the National Science Foundation for his project titled, "Collaborative Research to Explore the Spatial/Temporal Statistical-Physical Structures of Rain in the Vertical Plane." This research will expand upon previous work studying the temporal/dimensional analyses of the statistical/physical character of rain in the horizontal to include the vertical direction. Furthermore, this project will provide insights that will allow researchers to develop more accurate techniques for using Micro Rain Radars.
