Research-Practice Partnerships: Collaborative from The Spencer Foundation: LOI Late OCT 2023 & Proposal NOV 2023

[The Research-Practice Partnerships: Collaborative Research for Educational Change from the Spencer Foundation](#) supports education research with a focus on collaborative partnerships. Proposals should focus on research that will result in new insights into processes, practices and policies that improve education. **This opportunity funds up to \$400,000 for up to 3 years. The deadline for the Letter of Intent is October 2023 and full proposal deadline is Late November 2023.**

ARTS

Save America's Treasures for the National Park Service: Due FALL 2023

[Save's America's Treasures](#) is supported by the National Park Service supports two programs; Collections Projects include collections of national significant objects, and the Historic Property Projects include preservation and/or conservation work on nationally significant locations. **The Collections Project funds a minimum of \$25,000 and a maximum of \$750,000. The Historic Property Project funds a minimum of \$125,000 and a maximum of \$750,000. The proposal deadline is Fall 2023.**

Cross-Sector Impact Grants from South Arts: Due LOI 1 AUG 2023 & Proposal 2 OCT 2023

[Cross-Sector Impact Grants from South Arts](#) seeks to support programs that pair arts with another sector to great a greater impact in the community. Examples of sectors to partner with include the military, community revitalization or equity. **This program funds up to \$15,000 for first time applicants and \$10,000 for repeat applicants. The Letter of Intent is due August 1, 2023, at 11:59 P.M. and the proposal deadline is October 2, 2023, at 11:59 P.M.**

STEM



Herman Frasch Foundation Grants: Due 5 NOV 2026

[The Herman Frasch Foundation from the American Chemical Society](#) seeks to support research by tenured or tenure-track faculty (within the first seven years of the academic appointment) in the field of agricultural chemistry. **Approximately nine grants of \$50,000 per year for 5 years will be awarded.** In addition, proposals must provide opportunities for training graduate, undergraduate and/or postdoctoral level. **The full proposal deadline on November 5, 2026.**

(R15) Academic Research Enhancement Award fro Undergraduate-Focused Institutions (Clinical Trials Not Allowed): Due 25 OCT 2023

[\(R15\) Academic Research Enhancement Award for Undergraduate-Focused Institutions \(AREA\) from the National Institutes of Health](#) funds small-scale research projects to support research, introduce students to research and bolster the research environment of the institution. Proposals should have a research team that includes undergraduate students and/or graduate students. Proposed research should be established using preliminary data and/or published data. Project period is limited to 3 years. **This opportunity funds up to \$300,000 for up to 3 years and the proposal deadline is October 25, 2023 and February 25, 2024.**



HUMANITIES

Major Grants from the National Endowment for the Humanities: Due 9 AUG 2023

[Major Grants from South Carolina Humanities](#) supports grants for proposals of large-scale public humanities programs. SC Humanities is looks for proposals that promote public awareness of the humanities, builds collaborations with between local organizations and have a high chance of extended or lasting impact. SC Humanities strongly suggested to consult with SC Humanities staff prior to final application deadline. This opportunity **funds between \$5,000 to \$15,000 and the proposal deadline is August 9, 2023, by 5 P.M.**



Mini Grants from the National Endowment for the Humanities: Due every first business day of the month

[Mini Grants from South Carolina Humanities](#) supports proposals of small, low-cost public humanities programs. SC Humanities is looks for proposals that promote public awareness of the humanities, builds collaborations with between local organizations and have a high chance of extended or lasting impact. SC Humanities strongly suggested to consult with SC Humanities staff prior to final application deadline **This opportunity funds up to \$5,000 and the proposal deadline is due the first business day of every month.**
