William T. Grant Scholars Program: Due 5 JUL 2023



[The William T. Grant Scholars Program from the William T. Grant Foundation](#) supports career development, mentoring plans and research for upcoming early-career researchers. Four to six awards will be given out with funding of **\$350,000 over five years**. **The Mentor and Reference Letter deadline is June 14, 2023, at 3p.m. (Est) and application deadline is July 5, 2023, 3PM 9 (Est).**

ARTS

Grants for Arts Projects for the National Endowment for the Arts: Due 6 JUL 2023 & JUL 18 2023

[The Grants for Arts Projects from the National Endowment for the Arts](#) supports proposals that have public engagement with the arts, integrate arts with health and well-being of the grantee organization's community as well as bolster capacity and quality of the arts sector. **Funding ranges between \$10,000-\$100,000 and requires matching.** The application **deadline requires submissions on Grants.gov by July 6, 2023, at 11:59 p.m.** The applicant portal deadline is between July 18, 2023, at 11:59 p.m.

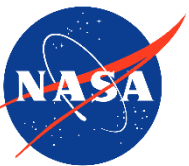
FY23 Dept of Navy (DoN) Science Technology Engineering & Mathematics Education and Workforce Program: Due 1 SEP 2023

[The FY23 Dept of Navy \(DoN\) Science Technology Engineering & Mathematics \(STEM\) Education and Workforce Program](#) supports proposals that bolster the STEM field, promotes growth of the STEM workforce, provides research opportunities and expands both mentoring and capacity of STEM areas. **This opportunity funds \$50,000-\$600,000. Proposals are accepted until September 1, 2023.**

2023 Human Exploration Research Opportunities (HERO) NASA: Due 10 NOV 2023

[The 2023 Human Exploration Research Opportunities \(HERO\) from NASA](#) supports research that falls into one or more categories of NASA's Human Research Program (HRP). This includes Space Radiation, Human Health Countermeasures, Exploration Medical Capability, Human Factors and Behavioral Performance and Research Operations and Integration. **Grant funding ranges from \$150,000 to \$1,000,000 and the application deadline is on November 30, 2023.**



HUMANITIES

Collaborative Research from the National Endowment for the Humanities: Due 29 NOV 2023

[The Collaborative Research](#) opportunity from the National Endowment for the Humanities supports projects that advance knowledge for the humanities by teams of two or more researchers. The research can either be in a single field or interdisciplinary. The project must aim to have tangible outcomes such as a book, peer-reviewed journal, a series of peer-reviewed articles, a digital publication or a digital resource. **The grant funds up to \$250,000 and the application deadline is November 29, 2023.**

**Fast Track Literary Grant from South Carolina Humanities: Due 8 JUN 2023 & 1 SEP 2023**

[The Fast Track Literary Grant from South Carolina Humanities](#) supports new or existing public literary programs, including writers' series, book festivals, conferences or writers' residences. The proposal program must take place at least 45 days after application deadline. Please note: SC Humanities will NOT fund expenses of research, writing or publishing of books through this program. **The grant funds up to \$3,000 and requires a 1:1 match** that can be cash and in-kind. **The application deadlines are June 8, 2023 and September 1, 2023, at 5 p.m.**

Archaeological and Ethnographic Field Research from the National Endowment for the Humanities: Optional Draft Due 16 JUN 2023; Application Deadline DUE 28 SEP 2023

[The Archaeological and Ethnographic Field Research from the National Endowment for the Humanities](#) funds empirical field research in archeology and ethnographic areas of studies by institutions. Award funds up to 3 years of fieldwork and data processing and funds may be used for research-related costs such as travel, accommodation, equipment and salary. **This grant funds up to \$150,000** for a performance period ranging from 4 to 36 months. **The optional draft is due June 16, 2023 and the application deadline is September 28, 2023.**
